



## YEAR END AWARD GUIDELINES

Qualifications for CPHC Single Class and/or Division Year End Awards:

1. CPHC Yearly Membership must be paid before points will be counted
2. Both the Owner AND Exhibitor (trainer or otherwise non-owner) must be CPHC members for points to be counted, including the Open classes and the Overall Open Horse Division. In the Open classes, the exhibitor does not have to be the same for all shows, but all exhibitors must be CPHC members for points to count.
3. You must show to 75% of the available judges (round up) for the calendar year in your respective classes. (Yearling & 2 year old requirements may be different than others based on when their classes are offered)
4. If you show at a show that is designated as "DOUBLE CLUB POINTS," your points earned under the judges at THAT show will be doubled. Double points does not refer to doubling the number of judges you showed to.
5. Placings are announced at our shows to 7<sup>th</sup> place. Therefore, the maximum club points you can receive per class is 7 per judge. CPHC year end points (per judge) are tabulated as follows:

In Halter Classes, Grand Champion will be awarded 2 extra club points, Reserve Champion will be awarded 1 extra club point per judge.

Year End High Point and Reserve High Point Overall will be awarded in 9 divisions, consistent with the High Point Divisions at the shows:  
Youth W/T, Novice Youth, Youth 13 & Under, Youth 18 & Under, Amateur W/T, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Open Horse, and Overall SPB Horse.
